Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Third Sunday of Advent for the year 2023. In today's Gospel, John 1:6-8, 19-28, the priests and Levites came from Jerusalem to ask John the Baptist who he was. John told them "He was not the Christ, not Elijah, nor the prophet. But he was the voice of one crying in the desert." "Make straight the way of the Lord. I baptize with water, but there is one among you whom you do not recognize, the one who is coming after me, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to untie."

John the Baptist's purpose was to prepare us for the coming of Jesus, to lead us to repentance, to lead us to Christ. John admitted he was not the Messiah, he was not the savior of the world. He was only the forerunner, a messenger, a servant. To untie the sandals of a traveler, then washing his feet, was the job of the lowest servant. This was John's position. This should be our position if we want to enter God's kingdom.

We must remember that we are not the savior of the world; we are not God's "greatest" gift to the world. We cannot fix everything. In short, we are not God. We need to stop playing God, to admit and to live it. Our accomplishments are because of the gifts God has given us. Any successes we have is due to our cooperation with God. We need to humble ourselves and admit that God is God and He us still in charge. It is in humbling ourselves before God that we are elevated. "We are never taller than when we kneel, both to pray and to obey." As John says of Christ, "He must increase; I must decrease." We must do the same.


