

Dear Fellow Parishioners.

Rosary

Today we celebrate The Fourth Sunday of Advent. In today's Gospel passage from Luke 1: 39-45, he tells us of Mary traveling through the hill country to see Elizabeth, her cousin, who is in her sixth month. She is carrying John the Baptist. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting her baby leaps with joy. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit said; "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

Here are two women who loved more, sacrificed more, and were more faithful to God than many others. Greatness and holiness are not always where you expect to find it. It is often found in humble ordinary people. In the foot hills, Mary didn't just believe in God; she acted on her belief. She said yes to God's invitation, she put her life in His hands. Her yes was her full expression of her faith.

This reading today is an invitation to each of us. Like Mary, we are all called to be an ark for God. Today we will receive the Eucharist at Mass. In this moment we truly carry Christ with us in sacramental form. We are a sacramental ark for God. Let's all carry Jesus to others. This is how we too become Holy.
