

Today we celebrate The Baptism of the Lord. In the Gospel of Luke 3:15-16, 21-22, all were asking if John was the Christ. He responds with: "I am not, I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of His scandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." Jesus too came to be baptized. Then the heavens were opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him like a dove and a voice was heard. "You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased."




