In today's Gospel, Luke, 2:22-40, we read of the presentation of Jesus Christ in the temple by Mary and Joseph. They offer two pigeons. The offering of a poor couple required by Jewish law. Jesus Christ, King of the universe, not only became man, but he became a member of a normal, humble, working class family. Mary, queen of heaven and earth, lived her holy life as a wife and a mother in a poor family. Joseph, worked hard just to keep enough bread on the table. Such a normal family, such and ordinary life. And that was how God chose to live when he came to earth.

God wants us to know that His Kingdom is within us: we can find Him in the midst of our normal occupations, where he wants to be with us as our friend. He wants us to know that true, lasting happiness doesn't come from having a lot of money, or things, or achievements, or celebrity. If those things were the secret to meaning and happiness, then Jesus would have been born into luxury and comfort. Real happiness comes from a kind of wealth that no one sees, the wealth of a heart that is set on knowing and loving God.

Is our wealth based on a heart set on knowing and loving God?

St. Wenceslaus Happenings

February 3: The Parish Council will meet at 6:00 p.m. in the Church basement.

We are hearing about a Jubilee Indulgence. What Is the Jubilee Indulgence? An indulgence is a special grace given by God, through the Catholic Church, for the removal of temporal punishment for sins already forgiven in the Sacrament of Confession. While Confession absolves guilt, temporal punishment due to sin still remains. Through an indulgence, God's mercy "reaches the sinner and frees him or her from every residue left by the consequences of sin", as Pope Francis explains. The Jubilee Indulgence is a special plenary indulgence available to the faithful during the Jubilee Year. It can be obtained – given the completion of the ordinary conditions – through pilgrimages, pious visits to holy sites, or works of mercy and penance.

Lent is just around the corner. Lent is a 40-day season of preparation for Easter. It involves seeking the Lord in prayer, giving alms, and practicing self-control through fasting. We could think of it as a spiritual tune-up, a time for us to think about our relationship with God and grow closer to Him. It is time to start planning what we will do to grow closer to God. Ash Wednesday is March 5 this year. Fr. Class will lead the Lenten program at St. Wenceslaus this year.

There will be a yard sale this summer. When you do your Spring cleaning and find those unused treasures, please consider the Church Yard Sale. Remember, no clothing, computers, or large appliances. Thank you.
