Rosary

In today's Gospel, Luke, 5:1-11, we read of Jesus borrowing Peter's boat to teach the people from off shore. After he had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets into the water." Simon said in reply, "Master we have worked all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a large number of fish. They called for another boat which they also filled. Upon coming to shore Peter said to Jesus, "Depart from me for I am a sinner." Jesus invites Peter to follow Him, for He will make him fishers of Men. They then left everything and followed Jesus.

"Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain." (Psalm 127) Peter had learned that if he was to catch fish, he had to follow the lords lead. So when Jesus ask him to follow Him, the choice was easy. He had seen and recognized what the Lord could do for him. Peter, like us, is going through life in search of meaning, in hope of finding something of value and was looking for a purpose. We labor in vain, if we do not find and follow Jesus.

Jesus gave Peter a purpose, gave his life meaning, and gave him direction. Following Jesus can do the same for us. Whether we are married or single, a cleric or religious, farmer or professor, banker or baker, what ever we are, following Jesus will bring us spiritual success. 
