Dear Fellow Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, John 8:1-11, we read of Jesus, the Pharisees, scribes and the adulteress woman. The Pharisees and the scribes bring a woman caught in adultery, a sin with a punishment of stoning to death. They question Jesus as to what they should do. He first bends down and writes on the ground with His finger. When they persist, He stands up and tells them: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." He bends down again. In response they left, one by one. Standing He said; "Has no one come to condemn you?" She said no one. Jesus said: "Neither do I, go and do not sin any more." This was a very embarrassing moment in this woman's life; She was exposed of her sin in front of the town's people. She was humiliated to the point of no defense. She was all alone in her disgrace, no one came to her aid. She was helpless. This was the point of the Pharisees, to test Jesus in the Law of Moses. They cared nothing for the woman. The law was more important than

Jesus was silent and wrote in the ground. We do not know what He wrote, but it was enough for the accusers to go away. Standing up He tells the woman to sin no more. He did not condemn the woman; He did not abandon her, but showed mercy to the woman, but did condemn the sin. Adultery was and still is wrong. Jesus had compassion on the woman and gave her a second chance. The accusers realized they were not sinless and so left. We are not without sin. Only God can judge. Only He knows all the facts. We can condemn the sin but never the person. (Continued on next page.)
