#### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, John 20: 19-31, the disciples were locked in a room for fear of the Jews. Jesus came and stood in their midst. He said to them: "Peace be with you." He showed them His hands and His side. Again He said to them: "Peace be with you. Receive the Holy Spirit, whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, whose sins you retain are retained." His message was one of forgiveness and mercy.

Jesus forgave His disciples for abandoning Him in His finale hours. He forgave them for not standing up for Him. He forgave Peter for denying Him. He forgave them for going into hiding. He forgave them for running away. But He also showed mercy to them by coming to them again and again and offering peace, no strings attached. Mercy is when God's love meets our brokenness. We all need God's mercy. We all need to see God's mercy.

Let's work with God and be forgiving and merciful. Let's be friends, co workers, cocreators, and evangelizers. Let's visit the sick, the imprisoned, the lonely, feed the hungry, help the marginalized, and give council when we can. Let us show mercy to those who are having a difficult time in life, both physical and spiritual. Help the one who is addicted, struggling to find God, seeking affirmation, or lonely. Mercy requires doing something positive for another. They don't need criticism, but a friend.


