Dear Fellow Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Luke 24:46-53, Jesus ascends into heaven. Before the very eyes of His closest followers, 40 days after His resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ ascended body and soul into heaven. Christ is God, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity become man. He is both fully God and fully man, a mystery so great that we cannot understand it completely. Christ's ascension, in other words, reveals His divinity, just as his resurrection did.

Many people throughout salvation history have been raised from the dead with the help of God's power. But only Christ rose from the dead on His own. As true God, He holds power over life and death, He is all powerful, almighty, as we say each week in the creed. Christ's ascension, reminds us that there is no limit to the confidence we can have in our God, because there is no limit to his power and goodness.

One of the main reasons He ascended into heaven was to claim for us a share in His divine life. Today on Ascension Day, Christ is sending us out into the world to be his witnesses, just as He sent out His Apostles two thousand years ago. And all we have to do in order to be as successful as his first Apostles is to stay as close as possible to our Lord. It is in our hands, to fulfill our part, to do our best, and God will do the rest.
