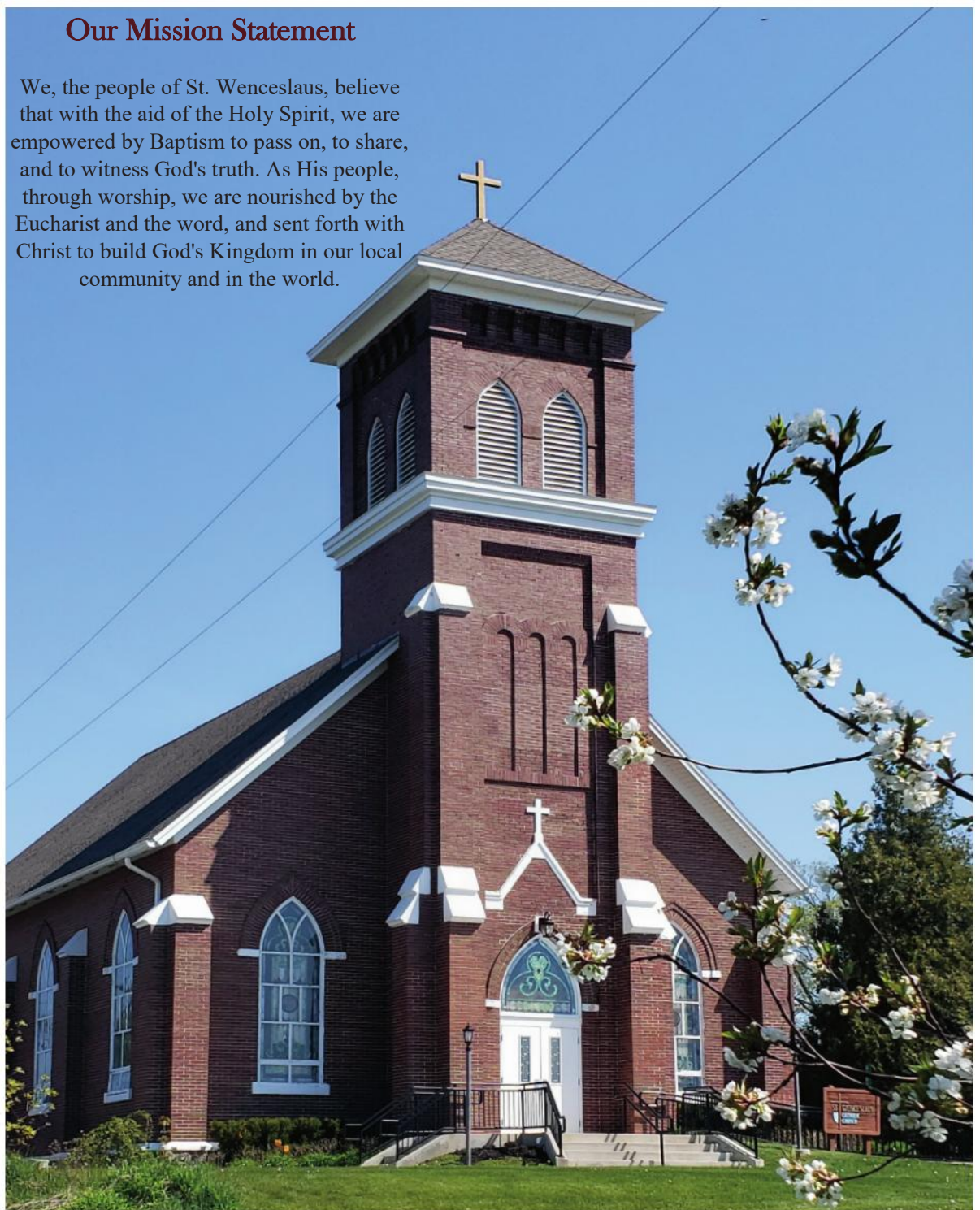

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. This is the time the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles in a physical way. This is a traditional narrative we hear often. It is one of the Glorious mysteries of the rosary. We meditate on the scene of the apostles, frightened and in a locked room, the sound of a strong driving wind, with tongues of fire descending on their heads. This is the time the apostles went public with the message of Jesus' Resurrection: The need for repentance and belief in Jesus Christ as the Son of God and to love as Jesus did.

This event gave them the courage and determination to speak of their conviction of Jesus Christ. They spoke in the language of the people, and the people understood. The Holy Spirit not only inspired the apostles but also affected the people in the street, for they understood the message and were baptized.

We often forget that there are nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost Sunday. The apostles spent that time together in an upper room in prayer. They were preparing themselves for something, not knowing what that would be, but open to it.

This same Holy Spirit that touched the hearts and minds of the apostles and the people in the street, is available to us. We have to spend time in prayer, take time away from distractions, and pray together, and be open to his words of wisdom and be willing to let go of our ways, our ambitions, our own habits and listen to the direction the Holy Spirit is giving us. We have to do our part so the Holy Spirit can do His part.
