

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20, the Lord appoints seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He warned them that they would be like sheep among wolves. To take no money bag, no sack, no sandals, and greet no one along the way. Stay in the same house, eat and drink what is offered to them, cure the sick and say to them; the Kingdom of God is at hand. If they do not receive you, say to them; the dust of your town that clings to our feet even that we shake off against you.


They are sent in two's to support each other, to share the message of the kingdom, and cure the sick. We are asked to do the same. To go out into the world and share the message. Not to depend on money, no extra cloths, no magic stuff, tricks or gimmicks. He wanted them to trust completely on the Lord. He wants us to rely completely on Him. He will take care of us in spreading His message. He will give us the words to say. He will lead us to the place we should be. He is telling us He will take care of us on our journey. Do not be distracted by the ways of the world. Shake the dust off your feet, take nothing from the culture that distracts us from the mission. Stay focused on the task and trust in the Lord.

He has given us the blueprint on the spreading of the Kingdom of God. He has told us what we need. That excess will be a distraction. Do not be distracted by a culture that does not receive the message. Do not take any message that is contrary to the Kingdom of God, not even a single speck of dust. Leave that town, move on to others. He is sending us on His mission, not ours. Trust in God, and nothing will happen to us; we will not loose our faith. Depend on God for the help to spread the Kingdom. Rejoice, you will be deeply rewarded.
