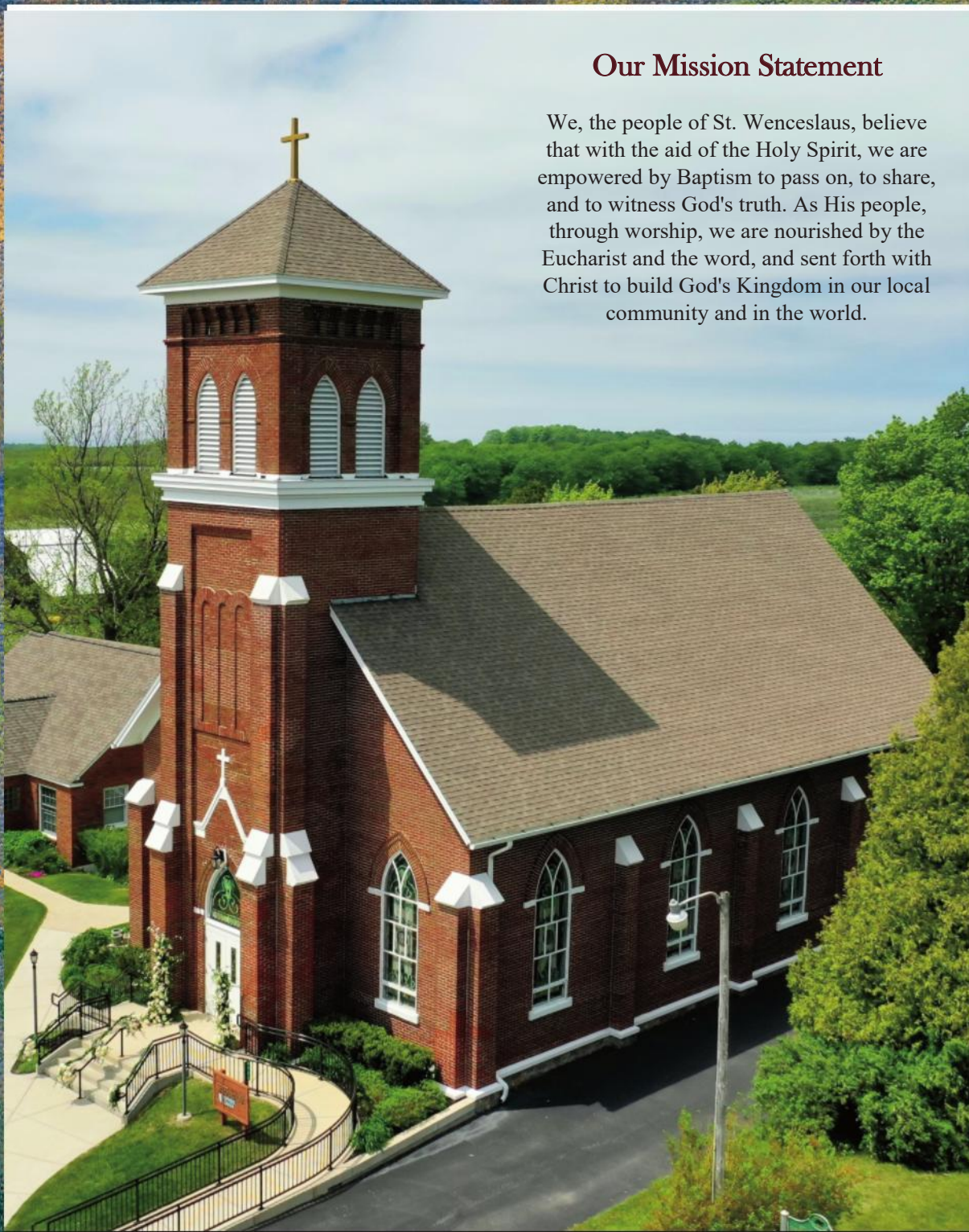

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel: Luke 10:25-37, a scholar of the law asks Jesus, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus asks, "What is written in the law?" The scholar responds with love of God and love of your neighbor as yourself. Then he asks, "Who is my neighbor?"

This prompts Jesus to tell the parable of the good Samaritan. A man fell victim to robbers. He was striped, beaten and left half dead. A priest passed by and walked on the opposite side of the road. Likewise, a Levite did the same. A Samaritan came by, bandaged him up, and took him to an inn and cared for him. The next day he instructed the inn keeper to care for him. Upon his return he would pay whatever the cost. "Who was the neighbor?"

Jesus is telling us that everyone God brings into our life is our neighbor. We are not just to know our neighbor: we are to become our neighbor. We are to create a neighborhood. By doing, by acting. Knowing is important because it shapes acting. We do not gain eternal life by passing an exam in theology. We get there by loving God and whatever neighbor God puts into our life, by doing.

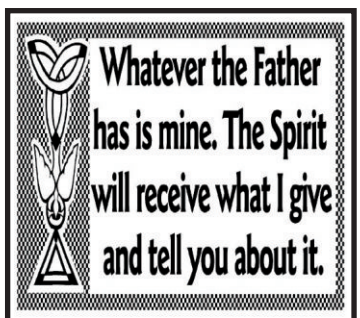
There are two great commandments of doing, not just one. The first one has to come first because God will always send you to your neighbor, but your neighbor will not always send you to God. The second is necessary. If we cannot love our neighbor, who we can see, how can we love a God who we cannot see? When we start making excuses, it is time to look at ourselves and love our neighbor, be a good Samaritan.
