Dear Fellow Parishioners.

Today we celebrate the Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel: Luke, 11:1-13, the disciples ask Jesus how to pray. He gives them the Our Father. Jesus continues and tells His disciples that they are to ask and they will receive, seek and they will find, knock and the door will be opened. The father in heaven will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him.

This saying about prayer is an amazing piece of good news, a life changing encouragement. God always gives us more than we ask for, not less. Why then do we not always get what we pray for? First we do not expect much. We simply do not believe Jesus' words to seek and find. We often expect little. Second, God loves us and knows what we need better than we do. We don't get exactly what we ask for, not because God does not hear us, but because He knows better than we do what we really need and what will be the very best for us in the end.


He gave us the Lord's Prayer. This is a model of how we should pray. Praising God, loving God, His will be done, submitting to His way, letting God be God, letting His Kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread, our needs, not our wants. Asking for forgiveness, as we forgive. It is a prayer reminding us of the two greatest commandments, Love God and neighbor. We say the words. We have to believe and surrender to one God.

Prayer is an acknowledgment there is a God. We need him, knowing our limitations, we are asking for help, for forgiveness. We trust He will respond to our situation. God will supply whatever we need, in accord with His glorious riches. Trust in Him. Trust in our prayer. Pray. Your Servant in Christ, Deacon Martin
