Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel: Luke 12:49-51, Jesus tells his disciples that He has not come to establish peace on earth, but rather division. From now on a household of five will be divided, three against two and two against three. There will be division in the family.

Today's Gospel is shocking. Jesus, the Prince of Peace, says that He came, not to bring peace but division and warfare, even within families. How can this be? Jesus is speaking of a different kind of peace. Not a worldly peace that the world tries to give through power. A kind of peace you don't need any religious faith to achieve. A peace that may end a war, only to start over again. As we can see through history, war ends only to start again. It is an external peace.


When we hear that Jesus brings division, it can seem contradictory to the peace and harmony we associate with His teachings. However, this verse reminds us that following Jesus requires making a choice, a choice that can sometimes lead to division within families, communities, or even within our own hearts. Jesus challenges us to prioritize our relationship with Him above all else, even if it means facing opposition or conflict from those around us. This division is not caused by Jesus himself being a source of discord, but rather by the response of individuals to His message of love, righteousness, and salvation.

The peace that Jesus is talking about is the peace He offered in the upper room after His Resurrection. It is an internal peace. A peace with God our creator. A peace that allows us to live in harmony with all of creation. A peace that allows us to love our neighbor. It is a peace of mind, peace of heart, and peace of soul. A peace we all long for. It is ours for the taking. Follow Jesus and His teaching.
