Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel: Luke 13:22-30, someone asks Jesus: "Lord will only a few people be saved?" His response is: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough."

We all have to strive to enter that narrow gate. That gate is very narrow; we won't be able to take much with us. We have to decide what we need to get rid of to make it through? For each of us it will be different. For we each have different baggage, different treasures, and a different relationship with Jesus.

It is like putting your hand in a cookie jar. You look and see what is inside. You reach in and grab a handful of cookies, you form a fist. Then you try and pull your hand out. The opening to the cookie jar is to narrow. You have to let go of something. So it is with our relationship with Jesus.



Whatever it is, we need to spend more time in prayer with Jesus. It is the only way for any relationship to grow.
