Today we celebrate The Exaltation of the Holy Cross. In today's Gospel: John 3: 13-17, we hear the famous words: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him."

The passage tells us that God loved the world. He came even when we were sinners because He loved us. Even when we ignore Him and made false gods. Putting our possessions ahead of everything else. He did not abandon us, or leave us to our own resources, out in the cold, struggling for happiness and meaning in life. He did not have to come, He owed us nothing. He sought nothing. He gets nothing. It was out of pure love that He came.




