#### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel: Luke 16: 19-31, Jesus tells a parable about a rich man and a poor man named Lazarus. The rich man dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. The poor man lay at his door, covered in sores, would gladly eat the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Both died. Lazarus was carried by angles into the bosom of Abraham. The rich man called to Abraham from the neither world for help. Abraham tells him that there is a great chasm between them and neither can cross. He begs him further to send someone from the dead to tell his brothers. Abraham tells him that even if some one came from the dead, they would not believe and change their ways.

Jesus is not condemning the rich man for what he did, but for what he did not do. Following Christ requires us to see our brothers needs and help them, do some thing for them. We are not to be self-centered, looking out for only our needs and wants. Christianity demands a love for the poor physically and spiritually. It demands embracing one's cross, as Lazarus did. It demands that we become Christlike. It is a choice.

Life has many choices. The parable also tells us there is an eternal consequences for the choices we make here. There are two lifestyles, two ways, two roads. The whole point of the road is to take us some where. Which road are we on? Where does it lead?


