Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel: Luke 17: 11-19, Jesus meets ten lepers on his way to Jerusalem. From a distance they call out to Him: "Jesus Master! Have pity on us!" He responds, go show yourself to the priest. On their way they were all healed. One, realizing his healing, returns to thank Jesus, falls on his knees, glorifying God in a loud voice! He was a Samaritan. Jesus asks, were not all ten cleaned? Where are the other nine?

The lepers were outcasts because of their disease. They were not allowed to go to worship with others, socialize with others, or be near anyone but other lepers. They were cared for by their families from a distance. They were cast out by the priests, so only the priest could allow them back into society. That's why Jesus sent them to show themselves to the priests.

Jesus reached out to these outcasts. He heals all of them, even the foreigner, a non Jew. He broke with the common belief. He healed those who most thought as nothing. He asks us to do the same. To treat those who are different than us, who think different than us, who look different than us, with kindness and generosity, less sarcasm, less bitterness, less judgment, less criticism. Be grateful for what God has done for us, what he has given us, and share with those who are less fortunate. Jesus reached out to us in our faults, let us in turn reach out to others as they are.

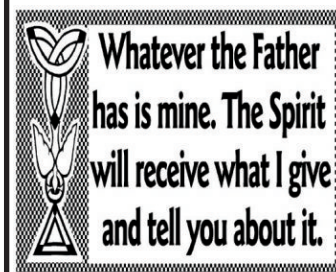
