#### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel: Luke 18: 9-14, Jesus addresses this parable to those who thought they were righteous. Two people went to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee told God how good he was compared to the rest of humanity. The tax collector stood off at a distance and prayed: "O God, be merciful to me a sinner." I tell you, "the latter went home justified, not the foremost, for who ever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

The two men in today's Gospel both did something right: they attempted to make prayer a part of their day. If we start the day with prayer, we are asking God for His help and for Him to be part of our day. If we don't, we are basically telling God that we don't need Him. We feed the body, we feed the mind, we exercise the body, daily. We should feed the soul as well.

In prayer we should not compare ourselves to other humans; we should compare ourselves to Jesus Christ. Pray like He did, live like He did. Prayer is the secret to taking in all the graces God has in store for us. Today He is hoping we'll decide to become better pray-ers and to be humble, for humility is the road to holiness.


Last week Jesus told us to pray often. This week He tells us how to pray. There is prayer and then there is good prayer. Pray to God with humility, admitting our dependence on Him. Acknowledging our weakness, and admitting our sinfulness. Asking for his mercy and forgiveness. Seeking Him for guidance. Following the example of the tax collector. Praying, "O God, be merciful to me a sinner." Be humble in our prayer.
