Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate All Souls' Day. In today's Gospel: Luke 7:11-17, Jesus visits the city of Naim. As he draws near to the gate He sees the only son of a widow being carried out in a coffin. Jesus had pity on her and said, "Do not weep." He touched the coffin and told the young man to arise. The dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother.

Jesus showed compassion to the widow. He knew in the Jewish culture that she would have no means of support; It would be very difficult for her to survive. She would be at the mercy of crowds to care for her needs. He often told the disciples to take care of the widows and orphans. This He did on that day by resuscitating her son.

Jesus was concerned about the widow and the dead son. He gave the son a second chance on life. He gives us many second chances in our life. Take advantage of them. But today our focus is on the soul's of the dead. On All Souls' Day we pray to Jesus for the dead.

We pray they have a speedy transition from this life to the next. We pray for the dead knowing there is no time in eternity. We measure the past and the future with physical dimensions that does not exist in the after life. We do not know what takes place at the transition from this life to the next. And so we pray for the dead as Jesus did, knowing He answers all prayers. St. Augustine remarked that he used to pray for his deceased mother remembering her request: "When I die, bury me anywhere you like, but remember to pray for me at the altar." Pray for the soul's of the departed daily.
