



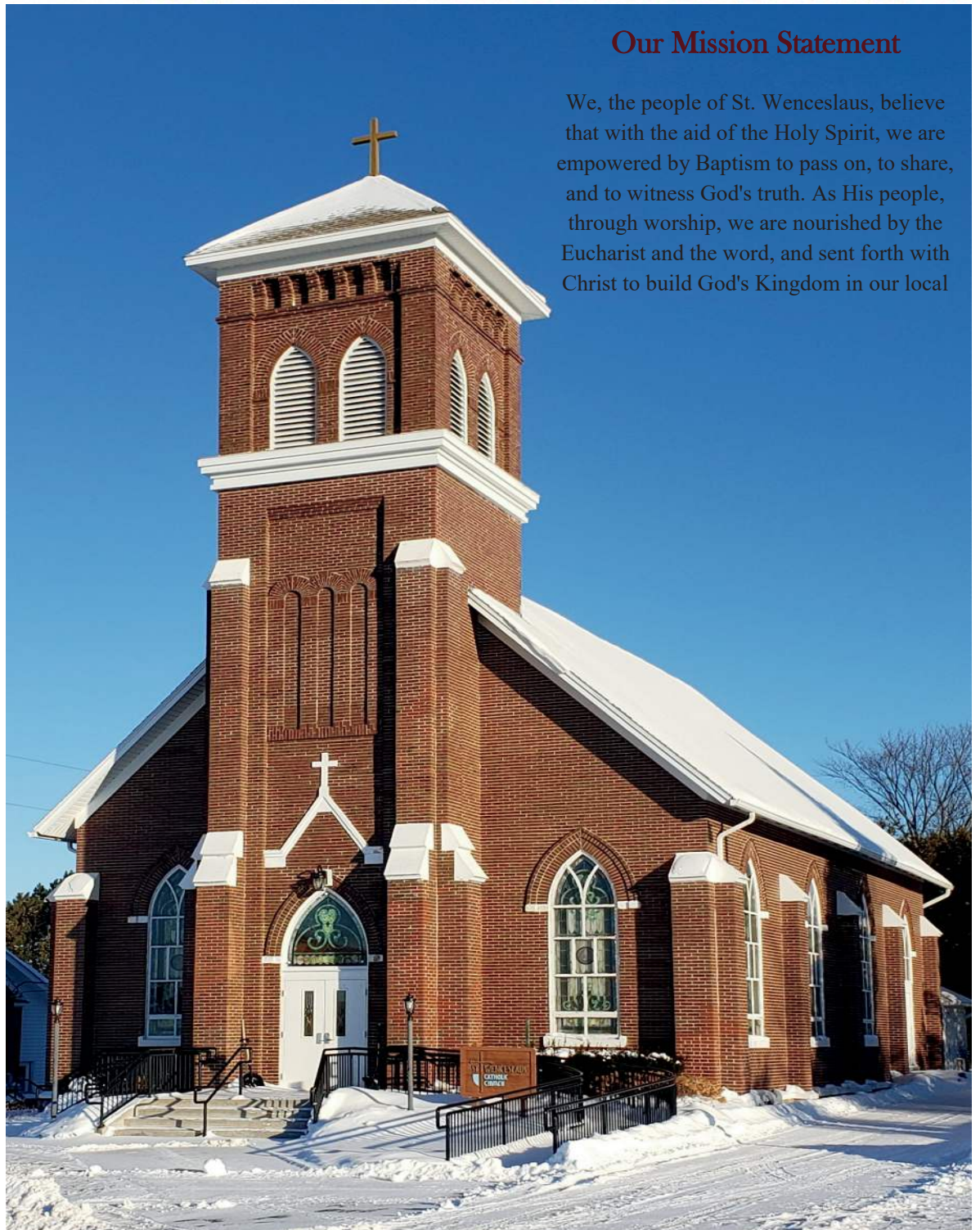

In today's liturgy, John 1:29-34, we hear the narrative of John the Baptist baptize Jesus Christ.
