


**Our Mission Statement**

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Second Sunday in Lent. In today's Gospel, Mark 2:9-10, we celebrate the transfiguration of Jesus. Jesus takes three of his friends, Peter, James, and John, up a high mountain by themselves. There He meets with Moses and Elijah, and His clothes become whiter than ever before. The apostles were terrified. A voice comes from a cloud saying: "This is My beloved Son. Listen to Him."

The three apostles got a glimpse of the Divinity of Jesus. The vision was not a dream. The apostles were fully awake and had their eyes open. It was not an imagination but a seeing, a vision of what was really there. Jesus always had the heavenly glory, but to protect our eyes He had kept His glory hidden from us until this moment. He does the same in the Eucharist. He actively hides behind the appearance of bread and wine. We with our human bodies need to be protected from His divinity. But He is really there.

Jesus is as real in the Eucharist as He was when He walked the earth with the apostles. We can talk to Him just as the apostles did, carry on a conversation, and listen to Him, as He speaks to us in the scripture. He has not left us, but our eyes are not able to see Him unless He lets us. He is here. We can become aware of His presence through prayer. Pray, He is waiting for us.

**Lenten service**: Wednesdays, Holy Hour at 5 p.m., Soup at 6 p.m., Program follows. The second presenters will be Members of the Infant Jesus of Prague community of the Secular (lay) Carmelite Order in Traverse City, in an attempt to answer the question "What is Carmel?", will introduce Carmel as the Garden of God, present a brief history of the Carmelite Order, describe the devotion to the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and introduce a few of the Carmelite Saints.

A Catholic Holy Hour is a devotional practice of spending an hour in Eucharistic adoration in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. This practice is deeply rooted in the Catholic faith and is a way for Catholics to show their devotion to Jesus Christ and partake in the abundant graces that come from this form of adoration. Here the Holy Hour usually includes the rosary, the Chaplet of Mercy, personal prayer, and Benediction.




