Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Easter Sunday, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. In John 20:1-9, Mary Magdalene comes to the tomb and finds the stone removed. She runs to tell Peter and John, "They have taken the Lord away and I don't know where they put Him." They both return to the tomb, but John waits outside until Peter came and entered. Peter found the burial cloth and the cloth that covered Jesus' head rolled up separately from the other. The other disciple went in and saw as well. They believed that Jesus had risen but did not understand the Scriptures that He had to rise from the dead.

We have the advantage of knowing the rest of the story. For Mary, Peter and John, they did not know what the rising meant for them and the whole world. This was the beginning of a whole new adventure for them, first in their own personal life, and then to those in the rest of the world. This would be the starting point for the apostles to preach the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. St. Paul would later state: "If Jesus did not rise from the dead, then we are fools to follow Him, and to be pitied."

We base our whole faith in Jesus Christ on this Resurrection. Our salvation is based on His mending our relationship with God. This is why He came. To conqueror death and to lead us to our heavenly Father. Without the resurrection we have no future. We believe and trust in Jesus. Without it life has no meaning. There is no other place to go. Believe!
