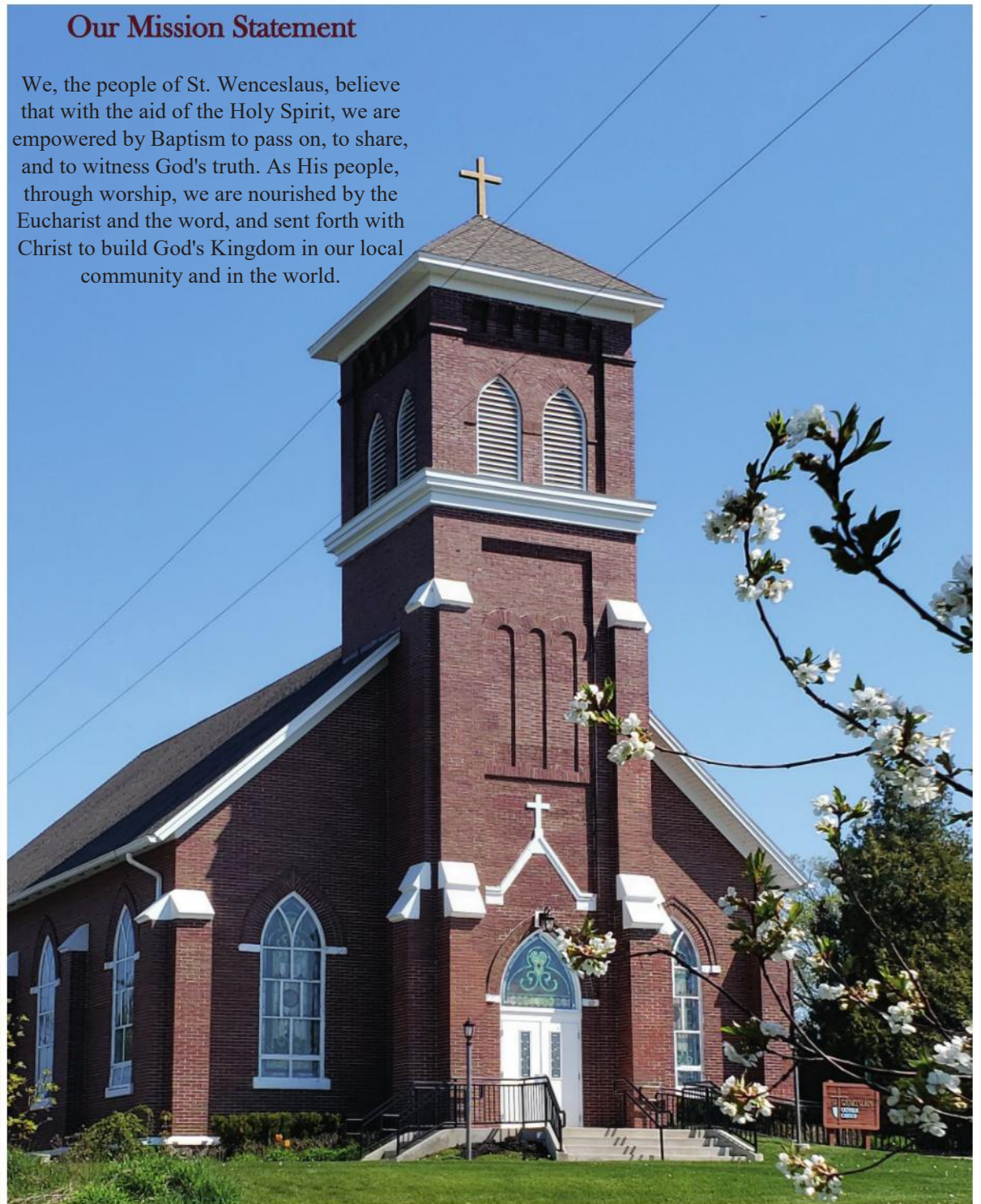

### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Easter. In John 10:11-18, Jesus tells His disciples that He is the good shepherd. That He knows His sheep and they know Him, and that He is willing to lay down His life for them, not just for His sheep but for others as well.

We know what Jesus will do for us. But He also says that His sheep know Him. That they will recognize His voice and come to Him. The sheep have to learn to respond to the shepherd. They have to trust in their leader that he has their best interest at heart, that he will lead them to green pastures. The sheep have a big responsibility to connect with the shepherd.

We are not like cattle that need to be driven, but like sheep who need to be lead. We are the sheep, Jesus is the good Shepherd. Jesus will always do His part. We have to do our part. 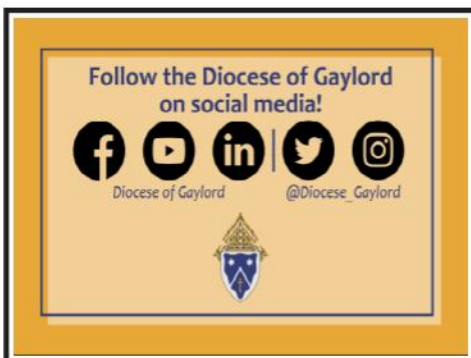
