

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter. In John 15:9-17, Jesus tells His disciples "As the Father has loved Me, so I love you. I have told you this so that My joy may be in you and your joy might be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I have loved you." You are my friends if you do what I command you.

In this Gospel, Jesus is asking us to do three things: keep My commandments, love one another, and to be His friend. Jesus gave us two commandments, love God and love your neighbor. When Jesus speaks of loving our neighbor, He is speaking of a self-giving love, wishing the best for the other. Love as He loves us. God gives himself wholly to us, first of all in creating us, because that was totally for our benefit, not His. And also from suffering and dying for us, which was also for our benefit, not His. This is the kind of love He is asking us to have for each other.

If we love as Jesus loves, we will be His friend, A friend we can go to, talk to, share are problems, our joys, our pain and suffering, whatever we wish. We will then feel His comforting touch, in our mind, our soul, and in our body. So that whatever you ask of the Father in Jesus' name, He may give to you. We all want to be happy. Jesus is the way. Follow Him.


