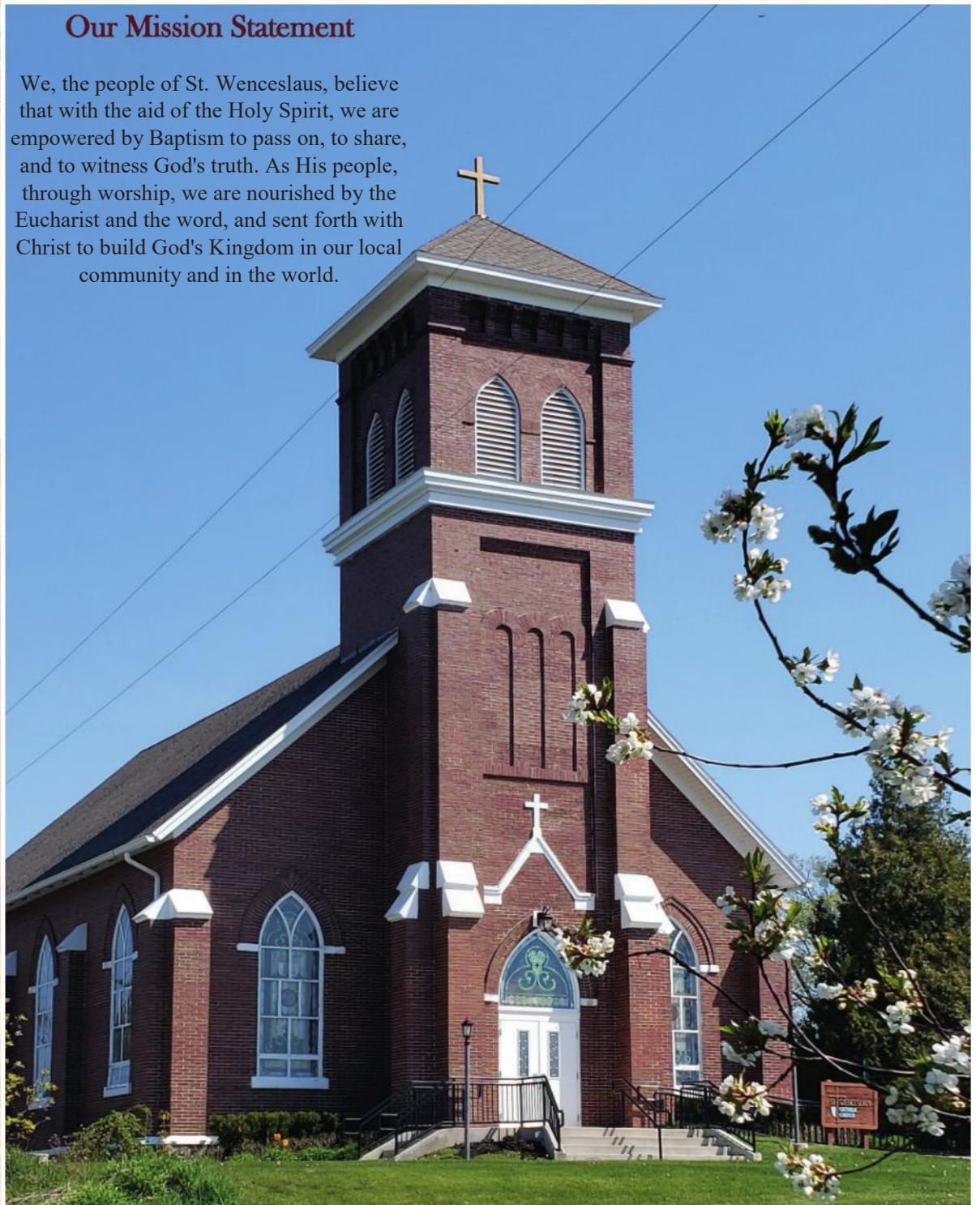

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In today's Gospel, Mark, 14:12-16, 22-26, gives an account of the Last Supper and the institution of the Eucharist. While they were eating, He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it, this is My body." Then He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and said, "This is My blood of the new covenant which will be shed for many."

When Jesus spoke, the world was created. When Jesus spoke all things came into existence. When Jesus speaks, things happen. At Mass, when the priest speaks in place of Christ, the bread and wine become Jesus' body and blood. Jesus is present in the form of bread and wine.

When we put out our hand or tongue at communion time we are really receiving God Himself. The God who is all powerful. The giver of life, the creator of all things, visible and invisible, coming to us who are His creatures. This great God comes to us in our sinful nature, to enhance our life, to draw us closer to Himself.

When we receive the body of Christ, we can focus on His great generosity and concern for us. He who is great beyond our imagination, comes to us in a form we can feel and touch. A God who we receive into our very nature. This God, whose human words can not do justice too in describing Him, enters into our life. How well do we acknowledge Him as to who He is and show our appreciation for Him?

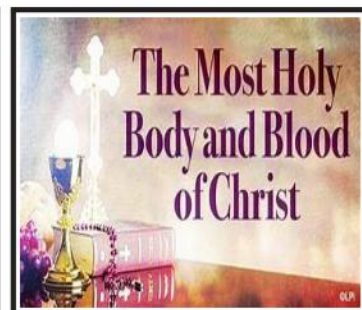
Saturday evening Masses will resume at 5:30 p.m. on June 29, the evening just before the Annual Dinner, thanks to Fr. Class.
