



Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 4:26-34, Jesus tells the parable about a farmer, who scatters seed on the ground and waits for it to grow. He knows not how. Of it's own accord the land yields fruit. God is at work.

Farmers, gardeners, botanist, lawn-care workers and others who work with the soil, know the importance God and nature in the growth of plants. Man is not in control of the outcome.
