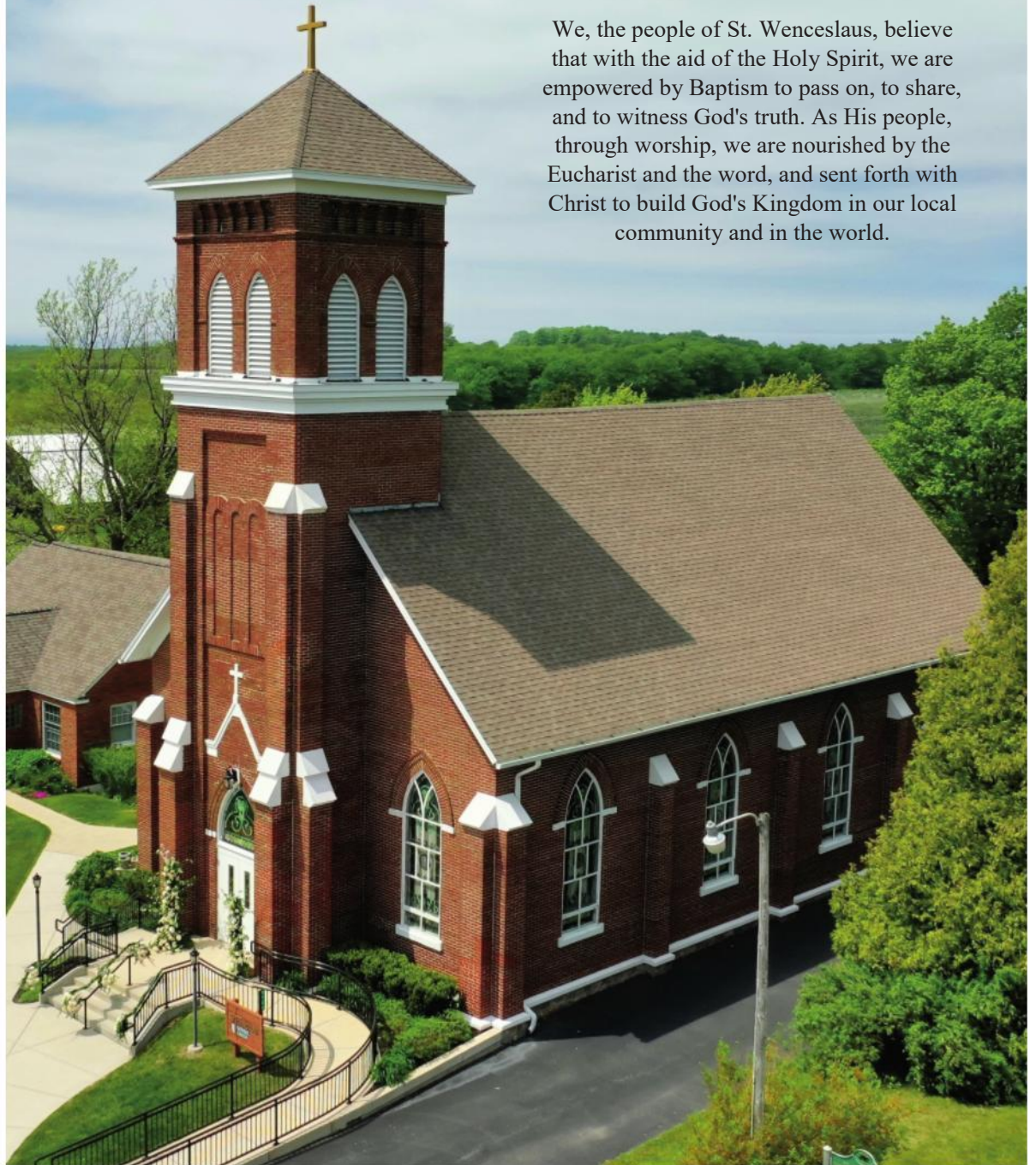

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 4:35-41, Jesus and His disciples are in a boat and a storm comes up. The disciples are working very hard to stay afloat while Jesus is sleeping in the stern on a cushion. They awake him and he rebukes the storm saying, "Quiet! Be Still." And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. The disciples were filled with great awe that even the wind and the sea obey Him.

The disciples had traveled with Jesus, had seen the miracles, and had many conversations with Him. Yet they relied on their own skill and physical ability to save themselves. They turned to Jesus only in desperation for help. Asking, "Do you not care?" Then they were shocked at what He did, that He could save them, that He would save them, that he could calm the wind and the sea.

There are many storms in our lives as well. They may not be in a boat with a storm, but they do happen. Difficulties and sometimes tragedies do happen to all of us. We do ask the question, "Do you not care?" We hear it often, "Why Lord, why do you permit this to happen?" We do not know the answer as to why God permits difficulties to happen in our lives. We do know there is much to learn from any difficult situation, that God is always with us, that we are not in charge, that God is, that God can make good things happen out of our mistakes. Be humble and trust in the Lord. He does know best.
