### Dear Fellow Parishioners.

Today we celebrate The Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 5:21-43, Jesus and His disciples arrive in a boat on the other side of the lake. A synagogue official, named Jairus, begs Him to heal his daughter who is near death. As they went on their way, they meet a woman who has been hemorrhaging for twelve years. She thinks if only she can touch Jesus' clothes, she would be healed. Jesus feels the power leaving Him when she touches his garment and asks who touched Me? The woman, embarrassed, comes forward. He tells her faith has saved her.

As they continue on their way the servants of the official come and tell him his daughter has died. Jesus tells the official not to be afraid, just to have faith. He allowed only Peter, James, and John and the child's parents to accompany Him inside. In the room where the child is, Jesus took her hand and told her to arise. The girl rose immediately. All were astounded.

Both the official and woman had great faith in Jesus. They had heard of the healings He had done elsewhere. They were confident that Jesus had the power to heal if they asked. Even when others said otherwise, they continued to have faith. They did not let the crowd convince them to forget about any healing.

We too, must have faith, not just hope, but a real belief that God will come through for us. We must have a faith that His will and plan is the best for us, that maybe our plan is flawed. That the crowd is not leading us in the right direction. A faith that allows us to trust in the Lord in the good times and in the bad. Then we too will hear Jesus say to us, "Your faith has saved you." How much faith do we have?


