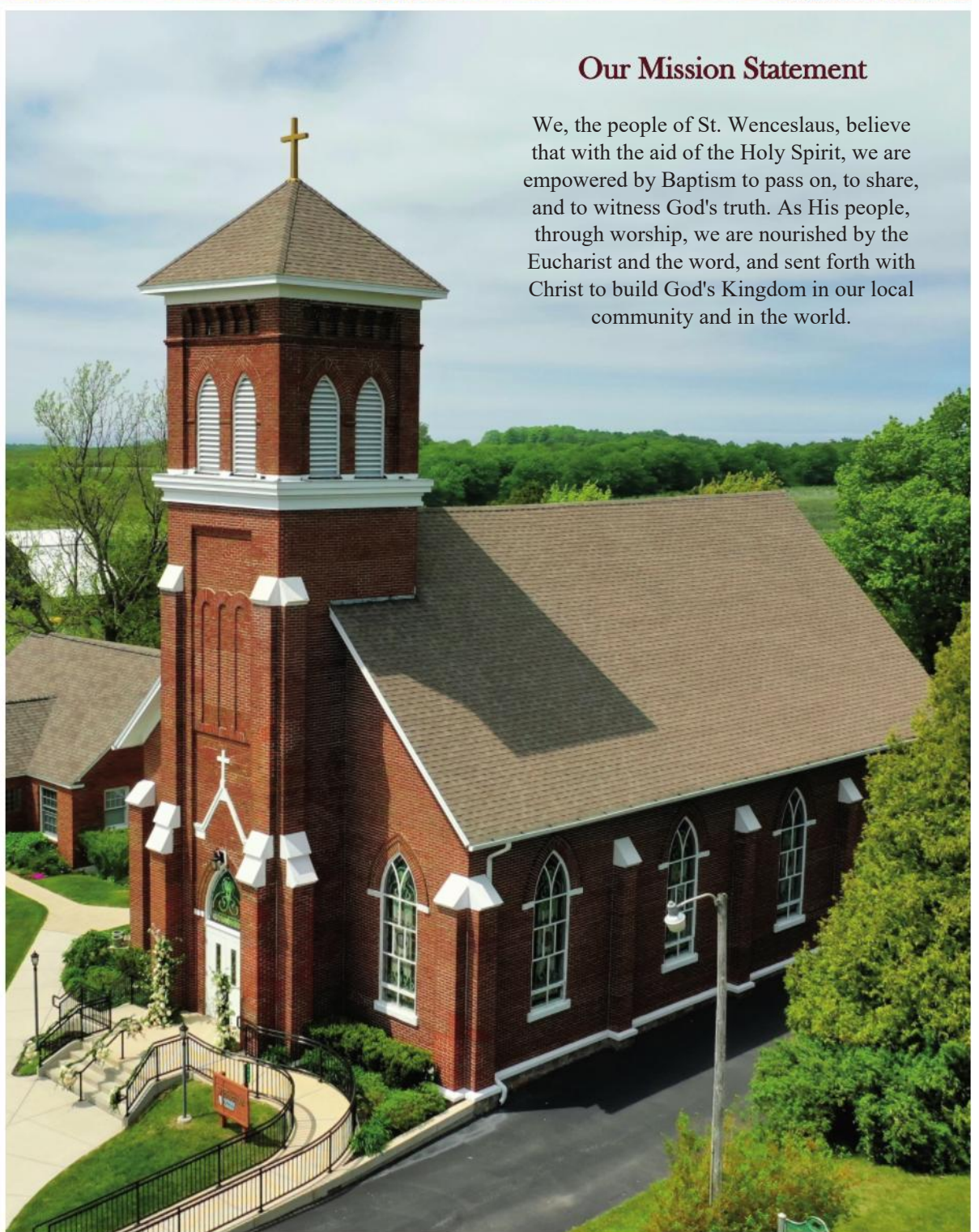

Today we celebrate The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 6:1-6, Jesus and His disciples arrive in His home town. This is just after He raised the official Jarvis' daughter and healed the woman with the hemorrhage. The home town knew of His miracles and who He is. That He was the son of Mary and Joseph, the carpenter. They wondered where He got all this. They were astonished.

They were astonished, they knew much about Him, but they did not have faith in Him. They believed in the stories about Him, the many miracles, and signs he preformed. They wanted Him to do the same in their town. To impress all that were there. To put their town on the map. They wanted to personally benefit from Him being in their town.
