Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 6:7-13, Jesus sends out His disciples two by two and gave them power over unclean spirits. They were to take nothing with them. No money, no food, nor any extra clothes. Stay in a house that accepts them. If not accepted, to move on to the next town. They were to preach of repentance and to prepare for the coming of Jesus to their town.

The message was to go out of their homes, out of their comfort zone to evangelize. That's His instruction for us, too. We all have different careers and professions. But we are all called to be a Christian. To be a Christian requires us to be a missionary in our own home town, where we are. He is sending us.

Jesus tells us not to take our security blankets: money, food, or extra clothes. We are to trust in Him to provide. He will give us what we need. He will give us the words to say in all situations. Our job is to listen to that intervoice of Jesus with in us. This is something we have to learn through prayer, not technology. Only God is God. Trust in the Lord.

Jesus also tells us we will experience rejection. Don't let it get you down. Move on to the next person, the next town. Learn from it. It may not be the right time for them. We are missionaries for God the father, who makes us an offer we can refuse. He is not the Godfather who makes us an offer we can't refuse. We all have a choice to move on.

We are to preach the good news. We are to also preach to the bad news, the consequence of sin. We cannot change humanities make up, or our DNA. We are not God, we don't have to fix what God has created; sin dehumanizes us. Sin makes us less than what God has intended for us.

Keep the faith. May your faith be not only in Jesus, but in Jesus' way, that it is best for us and others. Trust in Jesus in all situations.
