Today we celebrate The Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark, 6:30-34, Jesus' disciples return and report all that they were able to do. Jesus invites them to come away for a while and rest. So they got in a boat and go to a deserted place. The people saw where they were going, they hasten from all the towns, and arrived there before them. Jesus saw the vast crowd and had pity on them. They were like sheep without a shepherd and he began to teach them many things.

Jesus never tires of hearing from us. We sometimes give Jesus human traits. We were made in God's image; God was not made in our image. He will take the time for us. He is the Good Shepherd and wants to teach us many things.

Today the world is still confused as to what the truth is. It is nothing new. Pontius Pilate asked the question to Jesus, "What is truth?" Even at the time of Jesus, people where bombarded with many opinions. It was as difficult then as it is today. It is in hind sight that we become aware of what Jesus was talking about when He said: "I am the way and the truth."

We, too, need to hasten to Jesus and listen to Him. We will not find the truth in politics, government, the media, wealth, or the tabloids. The world does not know Jesus. It does not look to Him for the truth. We will only find the truth in Jesus Christ. Seek Him out as the people of long ago did. We owe it to our selves to seek the truth through the eyes of Jesus. It will be very comforting.


