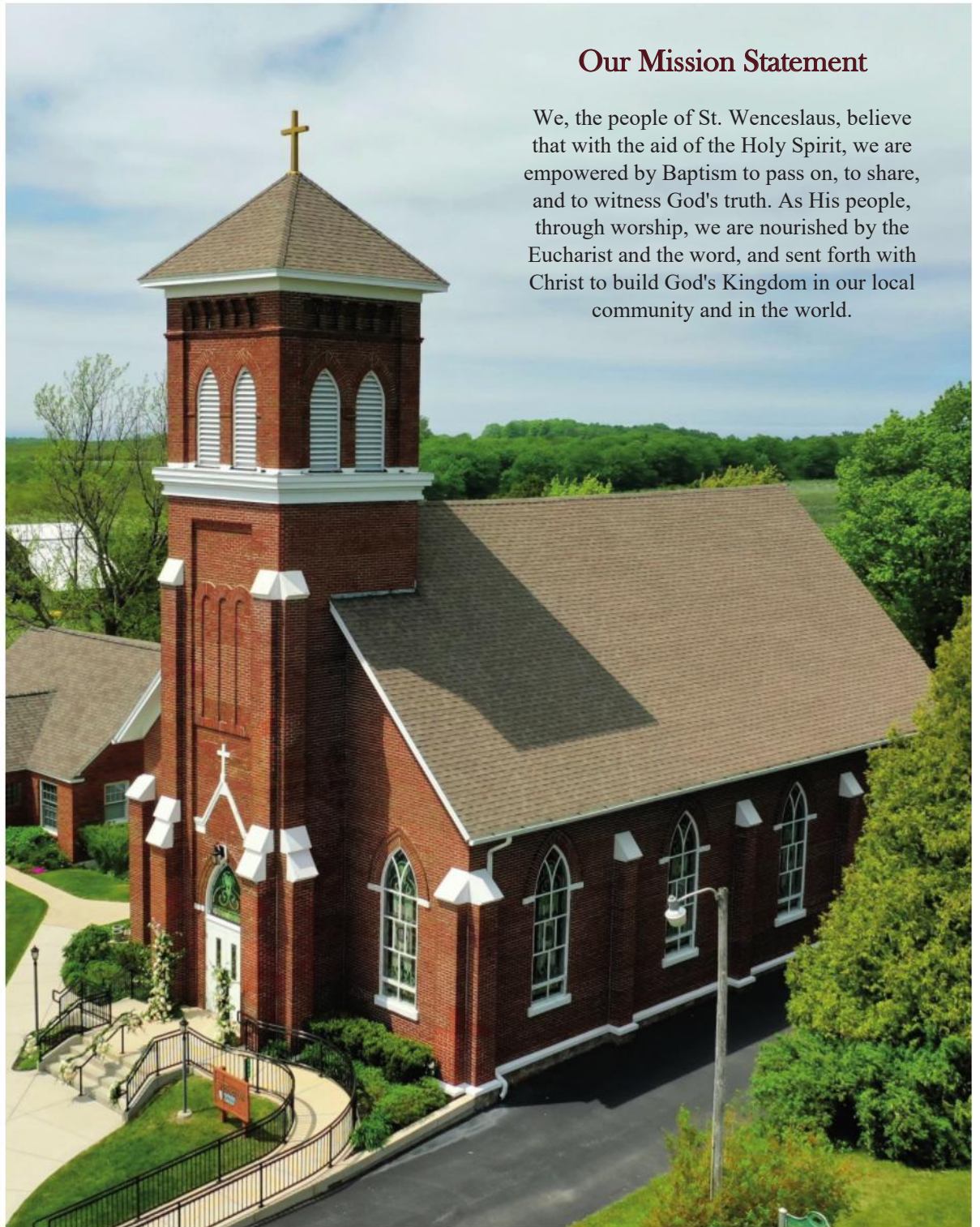

They were like sheep without a shepherd and he began to teach them many things.

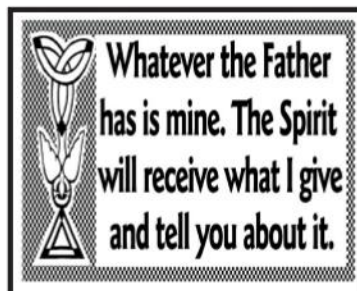
