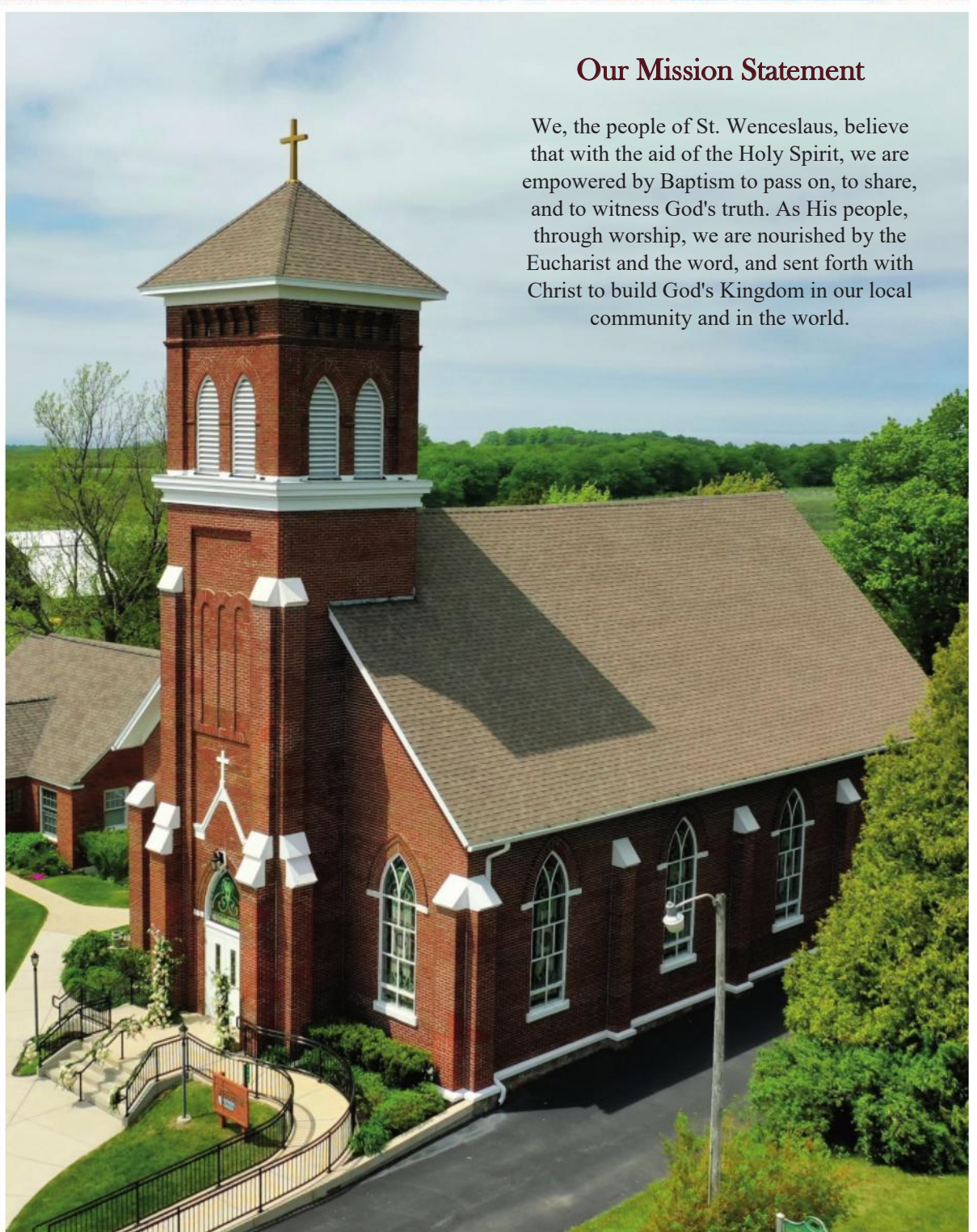

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, John 6:1-15, Jesus feeds five thousand men, not counting women and children, with just five loaves of bread and two fish. He takes the small amount of food, blesses it, and gives to His disciples to give to the people who were there for several days. They all had their fill, leaving twelve wicker baskets left over. When the people saw the sign He had done, they said: "This is truly the Prophet, this is the one who is to come into the world."

Jesus takes the little we have, the little we give Him, and can work great wonders with it. He can take our talents, our voices, our hands, our positions in life, our jobs, whatever we have and offer it to Him to use. He can take it and change the world. We have only to bring to Him what we have and He will multiply it many times over. By ourselves we can do nothing, with Jesus, anything is possible.

Jesus takes bread and wine, simple work of human hands, and changes it into the body and blood of Himself. We see a sign, a miracle happen right before our eyes. Heaven and earth coming together. Do we see it happen, do we acknowledge it happening, do we believe it happens? Jesus feeds more than 5,000 people every day with His body and blood. To be part of this miracle, we have only to attend Mass and receive Him in our hands and become one with Him.

Jesus performed many signs leading us to the Eucharist, the bread and wine becoming His body and blood. God being God reaches out to us in a very special way. We have only to respond to Him, and affirm his presence before us.

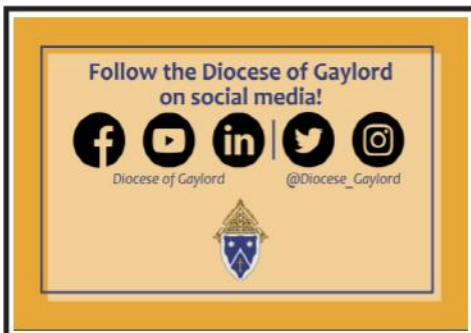
