#### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, John 6:24-35, the crowds go to Capernaum looking for Jesus. Jesus says to them, "You came looking for me because you ate the loaves and had your fill. Do not work for food that perishes but for food that endures for eternal life." They ask for this food. Jesus tells them He is the bread of life, whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst.

Jesus is telling us that earthly food may sustain us, but it will not give us eternal life, it can not save us. Much of what we strive for, search for, work for, can lead us to our creator only if we recognize them as gifts from the creator, not an ends in themselves. True Christians, in other words understand that **real fulfillment** comes from more than just making a living; it comes from **making a life.** We are to work for a life, not just a living.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is trying to move us from thinking of ordinary bread in our stomachs to thinking of the bread of life. Not just bread forever, not just living forever, but for eternity in the Kingdom of God.

Then He tells us that He is the bread of life. A difficult concept for them and can be difficult for us as well. This is His introduction to the Eucharist, the true bread of life, Jesus Christ. That the Eucharist is really His body, that He is spiritual bread to feed us, to give us eternal life with Him. We hear it from Jesus Himself. Trust Him.


