Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, John 6:51-58, Jesus tells the crowds: "I am the bread that came down from heaven, whoever eats this bread will live forever, and the bread that I will give is My flesh for the life of the world."

Jesus is shocking His listeners today because He is speaking in very real terms about the need to physically eat this bread that is His body and blood. Jesus is making sure that the people listening to Him know He is not speaking in mere symbolism.

What people, then and now, do not stop and think is that God, being God, can appear to us in any way He chooses. He came as a baby at Christmas, and we accept His coming. He grew into a man and many accept Him as the son of God. We accept His resurrection and His sending of the Holy Spirit. Should we not accept His claim of His presence in the bread and wine as His Body and Blood. And if so, then physically we are eating His flesh and drinking His blood.

Jesus is telling us this not as shock therapy, but to inform us that this is the way to happiness on earth, this is the way for peace of mind, this is the way to eternal life. He wants to have an intimate relationship with us. He wants us to be closer to Him than anyone or thing in this world. He is doing this because He loves us. Let us all show our gratitude to Him by spending some extra time with Him on a regular basis, in prayer.
