

Today we celebrate The Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark 10:2-16, we contemplate the sanctity of marriage and the boundless love of Jesus for children. Instead, Jesus turns the conversation back to God's original intent for marriage, reminding us that it is a sacred covenant between male and female meant to reflect God's love. In a world that often trivializes relationships, we are called to recognize marriage as a lifelong commitment rooted in love, fidelity, and mutual respect. When we encounter difficulties in our marriages, we must remember that love is not merely a feeling; it is a "decision" to remain faithful, to communicate openly, and to forgive.

Today we are reminded and invited to foster a culture of love and respect, recognizing that each relationship reflects God's love for us. The comfort comes in knowing that Jesus cares deeply for each of us, especially those who may feel marginalized or overlooked—like children in a busy world.


Let us pray for the grace to embrace the challenges of our relationships and to welcome all with open arms, just as Christ does.
