Today we celebrate The Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel passage from Mark 10:35-45, James and John, the son's of Zebedee, ask Jesus: "When you enter into your glory, may we sit one at your right and one at your left?" Jesus responds with: "Can you drink of the cup that I drink?" They respond with "We can." Jesus counters their request by stating, "Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant."

This redefinition of greatness challenges us to reconsider our own pursuits. Are we striving to be served, or are we willing to serve others? In a world that often equates success with dominance, Jesus invites us into a different way of living—one rooted in love and service.

This notion of servanthood is countercultural. In a society that often celebrates individual achievement and personal gain, Jesus calls us to find our purpose in lifting others. Consider practical ways to serve those around you—whether through volunteer work, offering support to a neighbor, or simply being present for someone in need. These acts, no matter how small, can have a significant impact on others and lead to personal fulfillment. Follow Jesus example of service to others.

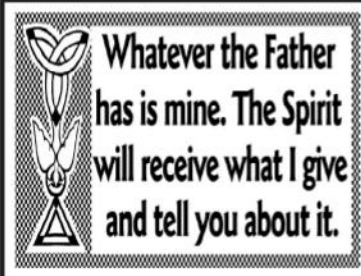
