Jesus responds with: "Can you drink of the cup that I drink?" They respond with "We can." Jesus counters their request by stating, "Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant."

This redefinition of greatness challenges us to reconsider our own pursuits. Are we striving to be served, or are we willing to serve others? In a world that often equates success with dominance, Jesus invites us into a different way of living—one rooted in love and service.


