Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel passage from Mark 10:46-52, Jesus is on a journey from Jericho. A blind man, Bartimaeus, calls to Him for pity. The crowds try to silent him, but he continues to call out all the more. Jesus calls for him to come. The man springs up, puts aside his cloak, and comes to Jesus, and asks to be able to see. Jesus said to him: "Go your way, your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.

We live in a world much like Bartimaeus. We are blind to many things in this world, We are sinners in need of salvation. We are blinded by our secular world view. We all seek and look for a healing. Something more rewarding, something more fulfilling, something, maybe like Jesus Himself. But our world tells us no, to be quiet, we are rebuked for calling out to Jesus. We are told to keep our belief to our self. Let it die inside us by itself.

This is what the world wants, to silence us. But Bartimaeus continued to call out. We must be consistent in calling out to Jesus, listening for His voice. He is calling us through Scripture, our neighbor, each other, even Hollywood. We have to learn to listen to Jesus voice. We respond sometimes with words, sometimes by our actions, but always by our behavior. By sharing, caring, and loving our neighbor at all times. Don't let Him pass by without calling to Him. Receive Him often in the Eucharist. For Jesus is the way.
