Today we celebrate The Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel passage from Mark 12:38-44, Jesus becomes aware of the scribes and their seeking of attention and places of honor. He also observed the rich in putting large sums of money in the temple treasury, while a poor widow put in two small coins worth a few cents. Jesus tells His disciples that the widow put in more than all the others. The rich gave out of their surplus, but she gave out of Her poverty.

Jesus is telling us that it is the attitude in wish we give. To give from the heart, until we can give it all to God, for the more we give, the more will be given to us. It is better to give freely what God has given each of us recognizing all is gift from Him. All we have is given to us to share. And sharing, God will share more.


