Today we celebrate The Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel passage from Mark 13:24-32, Jesus tells His disciples about the end times. The sun will be darkened, the noon will not give it's light, and the stars will fall from the sky, and the powers of heaven will be shaken. The universe will be changed, it is mortal. The Son of Man will come to gather the elect. But of that day no one knows.

Jesus is telling us that there is an end time. That all that we see is mortal, will pass away. The Sun, the stars, the planets, the whole universe is temporary. That only His word will not pass away. Learn and know the signs. This generation will not pass away until all these things take place. Jesus is using the word generation different than we often think. God is not mathematical. God uses a different clock.






