



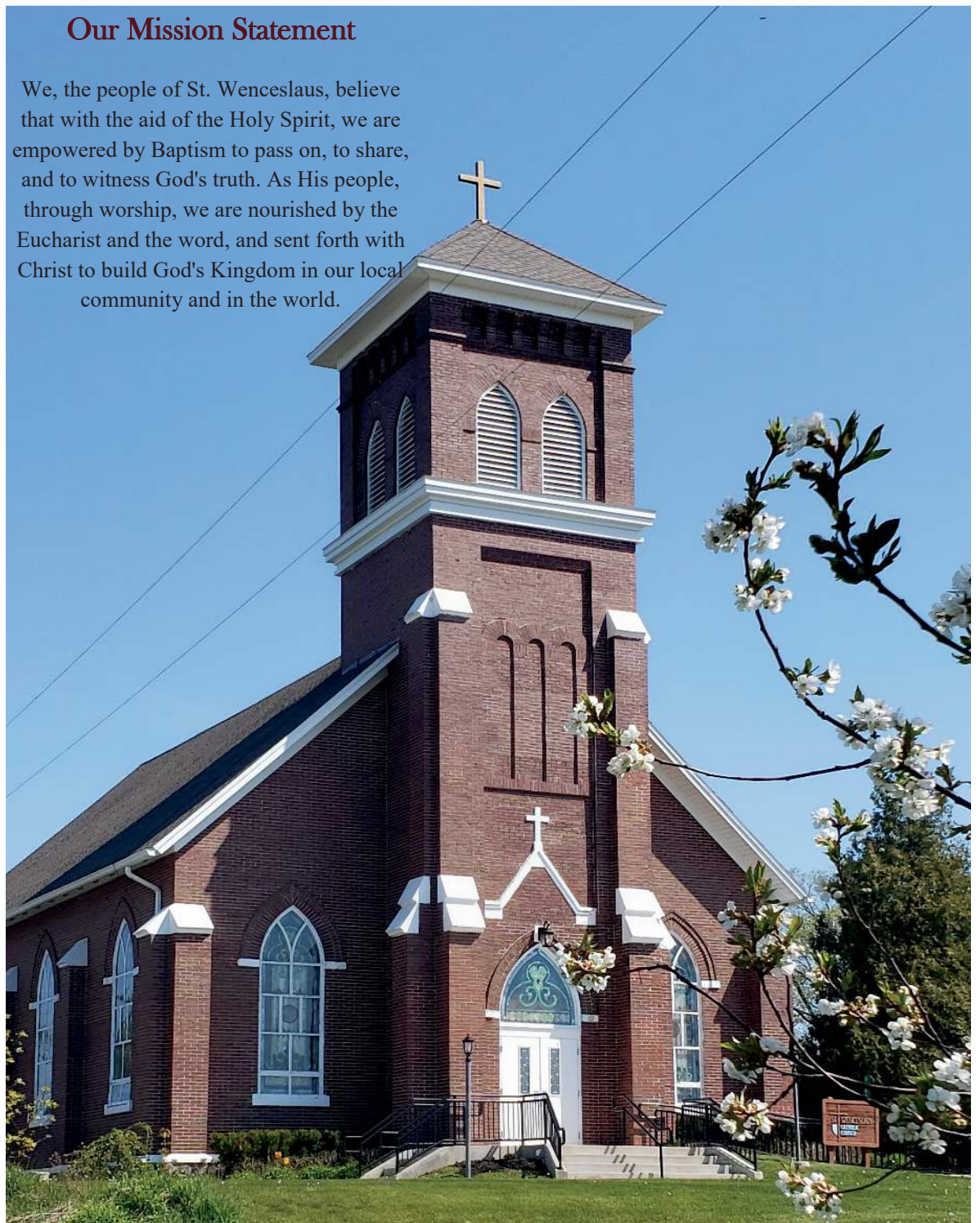

Dear Friends in Christ,

In today's liturgy, we hear the famous quote of John 3:16, "God so loved the world that He sent his only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish, but might have eternal life." This is a simple message. Easy to understand, not too difficult to read, and even to share. God came to us, He came to us in our flawed nature, in our sinfulness. He could have condemned us. But He didn't. We distance our selves from Him, not He from us.

God is always present to us in a special way: He sustains us in existence every moment. If He were to stop thinking about us, we would cease to exist. But He never stops thinking about us, so we are here. He thinks about us, but we often think about worldly things. Putting them before God in many ways. We are distracted by the things He has created and by things we make. But He is still there waiting for us to respond.

The Son came into the world to reveal to us a way to get closer to Him, to close the gap between us. He did not come to condemn us, but wants our friendship. He wants us to have a good life here and in the here after. He never ceases to seek us out, He will find us. We only have to respond to His invitation. If we do, our life will be changed forever, for the better. Give God a chance.
